* Filmmaker may only submit one project per round of consideration. Multiple projects will not be considered.

Submitted applications, DVD's and other materials will not be returned. Due to the high volume of submissions received, the Native Program cannot provide feedback or critique on individual projects.

Proposals will go through a rigorous selection process where they are reviewed by Sundance staff. All projects considered will be notified of decisions by April 25th, 2012

Packages must be received by Wednesday, FEBRUARY 1st 2012, Late submissions will not be considered.
