HOW TO GET TICKETS

OPEN TICKET SALES

MAIN BOX OFFICES

January 17–29

Show up at one of our Main Box Office locations to purchase your tickets.

ONLINE

January 17–27

Tickets are available online until 36 hours before showtime. Order online and come to a Main Box Office at least two hours prior to the screening for ticket pickup.

DAY-OF-SHOW SALES

January 19–29

Didn't get the tickets you wanted to a sold-out screening? Come into our Main Box Offices in Salt Lake City or Park City to get tickets to many previously unavailable screenings. Each morning at 8:00 a.m., we release a limited number of tickets to that day's screenings. Tickets for each theatre's first screening of the day are released at 8:00 a.m. the day before. Day-of-show tickets must be purchased in person; they are not available online.

Fees apply to online orders. Chase SapphireSM is the official credit card of the 2012 Sundance Film Festival, but all major credit cards are accepted online and at Main Box Offices.

WAITLIST TICKET SALES

January 19–29 (includes Day One films)

Every year thousands of Festivalgoers see popular films without advance tickets.

How It Works

Arrive at the theatre of your choice two hours before the published screening time, except for each theatre's first screening of the day, when you may arrive one hour before the published screening time.

- Receive a waitlist number (one per person). You may leave the line.
- Return no less than 30 minutes before the published screening time.
- Line up according to number.
- Purchase available tickets, which are sold to the line by number.
- Tickets are \$15.00.

Waitlisters returning less than 30 minutes before the published screening time must go to the end of the line regardless of their number.

Restrictions

- CASH ONLY
- Exact change is recommended.
- Saving places in line is NOT permitted.

A waitlist number does not guarantee tickets are available for purchase. If no space is available, ticketed waitlist patrons receive a full refund. All timetables for waitlist tickets are subject to change at the discretion of the theatre manager.

EXCHANGES

There are no refunds, but you may exchange your tickets up to two hours before the screening by visiting any Main Box Office during regular business hours. A fee of \$2.00 per ticket applies. Theatre box offices cannot exchange tickets.

TICKET PICKUP

Patrons who purchased individual tickets online and did not order express delivery must pick up their tickets during normal business hours at any Main Box Office. You must present a photo ID to receive your tickets. Please pick up your tickets at least TWO HOURS before your first screening time. Tickets for screenings prior to 10:00 a.m. should be picked up the day before because heavy traffic is expected in the Main Box Office during the early morning hours. Tickets for screenings after 7:00 p.m. must be picked up during regular Main Box Office hours. There is no ticket pickup at the theatres. Be sure to select tickets that coincide with your arrival time and the Main Box Office hours of operation.

THEATRE REGULATIONS

All patrons—whether credentialed or ticketed—must adhere to the following guidelines posted at each theatre.

- 1 To guarantee admittance, ticket and eligible pass holders must be in the appropriate line at least 15 minutes prior to the film's published start time.
- 2 The use of cameras or other recording equipment is strictly prohibited during the screening.
- 3 Filmgoers should remember to take all personal belongings and litter with them as they exit. Any items left behind may be disposed of.
- 4 The Sundance Film Festival reserves the right to search the personal belongings of any patron inside or around the premises of the theatres.
- 5 By entering the theatre, patrons consent to be photographed/ filmed and grant Sundance Institute and its successors—
- 6 signed parties, carrier stations, network station(s), sponsor(s), advertising agents, and their affiliated entities—the right to record and use their likeness, voice, and name worldwide in perpetuity for any purpose whatsoever. In addition, they release the above parties from any and all liability for loss or damage to person or property while they are at or around the theatre.
- 6 Once inside theatres, all cell phones and electronic devices must be turned off prior to the introduction of the film.
- 7 All filmgoers agree to comply with all published and stated rules and regulations.
- 8 No babies in arms or strollers are permitted in theatres. Pets, except for service animals, are also not allowed.

GETTING AROUND

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

SHOULD I RENT A CAR IN PARK CITY?

No. Parking is limited in Park City, and the Festival shuttle buses are the best way to get around town. They offer free and convenient access to all venues and theatres.

HOW DO I GET AROUND WITHOUT A CAR?

Free shuttle buses travel frequently between Park City venues. Buses operate daily from 7:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. The last bus leaves the Old Town Transit Center at 2:20 a.m. Park City Transit offers a comprehensive free shuttle service around Park City. For additional route information, go to any Information Booth or shuttle stop, or ask a Festival Insider.

CAN I WALK AROUND PARK CITY?

Yes. Walking is a great option in Park City; lighted pedestrian paths and sidewalks throughout town are often the quickest way to get around, and the best way to see the town. Remember that it's winter, so the weather can change quickly; be sure to dress appropriately.

WHERE DO I PARK IF I NEED A CAR?

Park at your lodging or at a designated Park and Ride lot.

FESTIVAL DESIGNATED PARKING LOTS

THE YARD PARK AND RIDE—NEW FOR 2012

The New Frontier venue is now located at The YARD. Park here to visit an exciting venue full of art, film, and media installations.

The YARD Park and Ride is also the starting point for the Temple Theatre Express shuttle route. There is NO parking at the Temple Theatre. The YARD is a large lot, easily accessible for patrons going to the Eccles Theatre, Headquarters, The MARC (formerly The Racquet Club), and the Prospector Square Theatre. It's also only a short walk to New Frontier, the Holiday Village Cinemas, and the Yarrow Theatre. The free Festival shuttle picks up right in front of The YARD. There is a \$15 cash-only fee per entry. Parking in nondesignated areas will result in immediate towing.

CHINA BRIDGE PARKING STRUCTURE

The China Bridge parking structure is located two blocks east of Main St., making it perfect for a quick stroll to the Egyptian Theatre, Main Street Festival Store, Festival Co-op, Sundance House Presented by HP, Filmmaker Lodge, and other Main Street venues. It's also a quick walk to the Old Town Transit Center, where free Festival and city buses will take you to the Library Center Theatre and other venues. Cash fee of \$20 per entry January 20–23. Cash fee of \$10 per entry January 24–28. Please enter the lot on Marsac Ave.

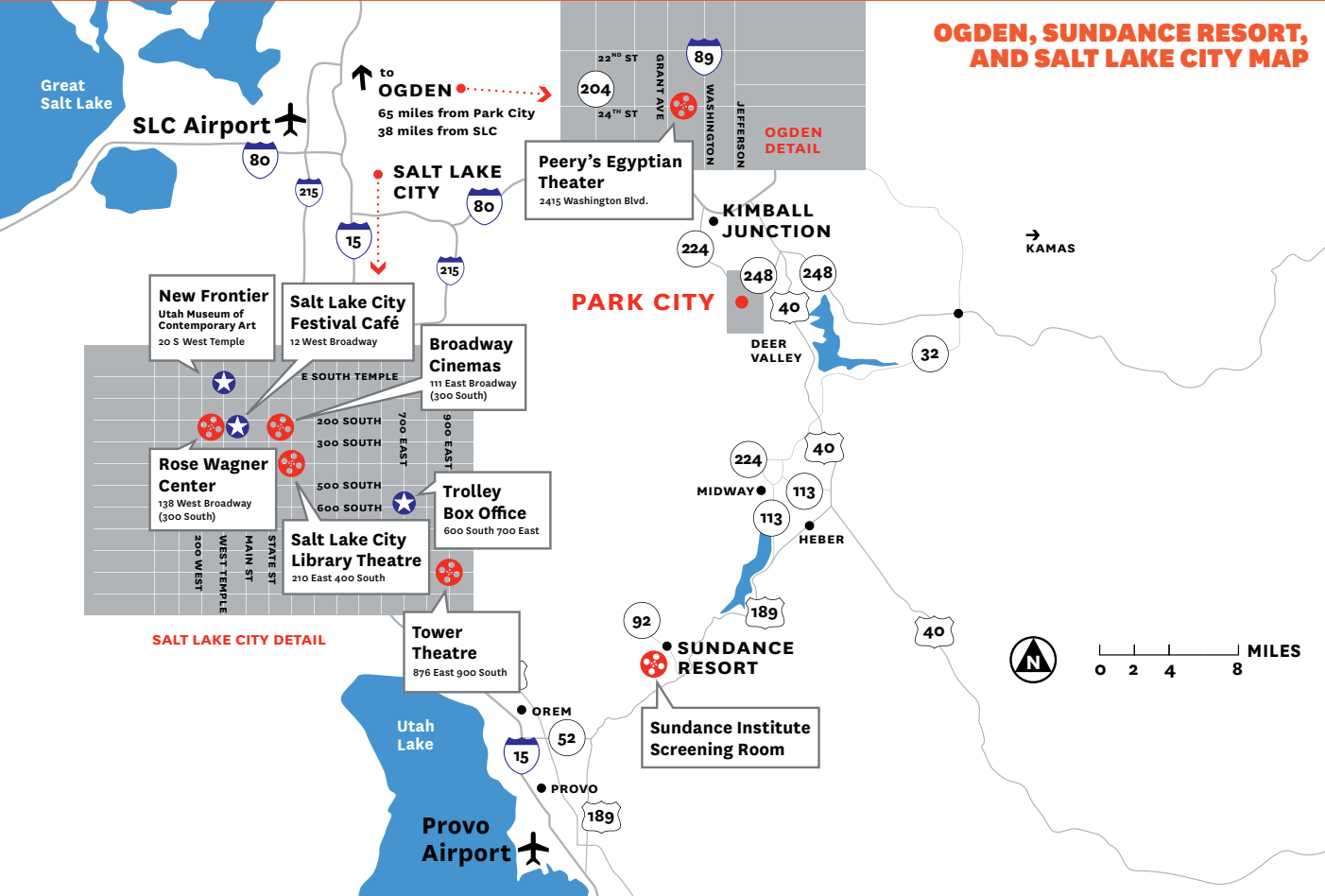

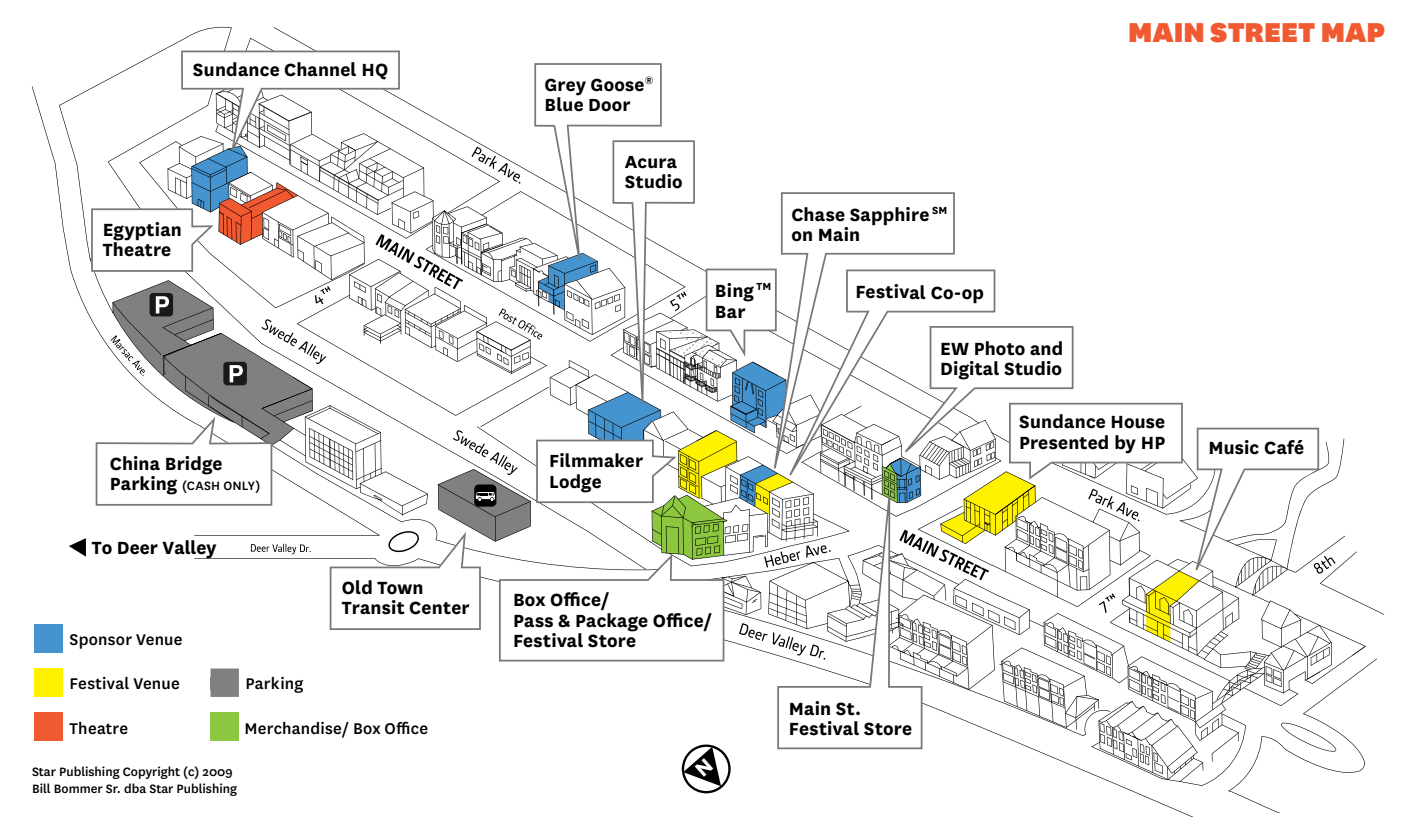
ADA ACCESSIBILITY

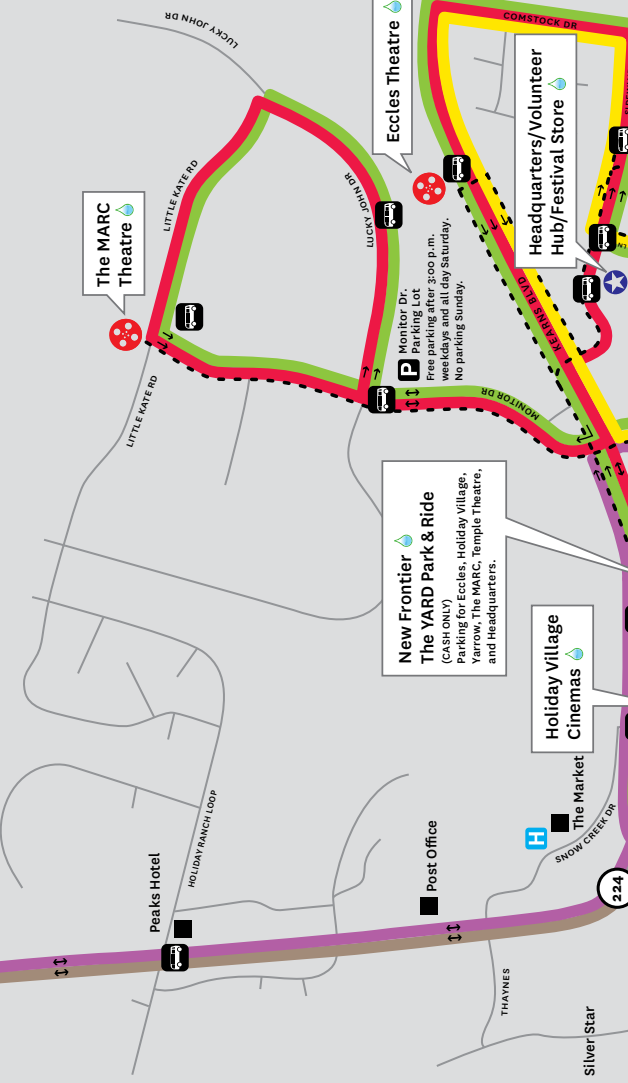
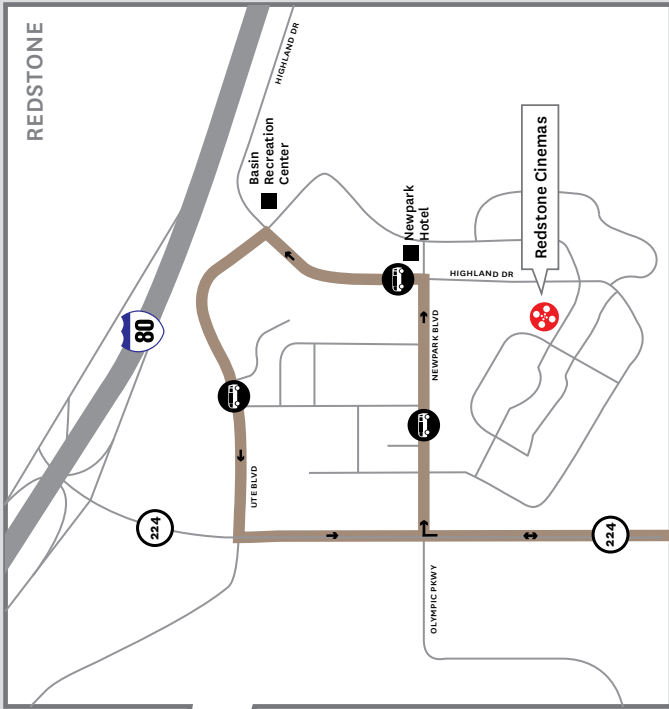

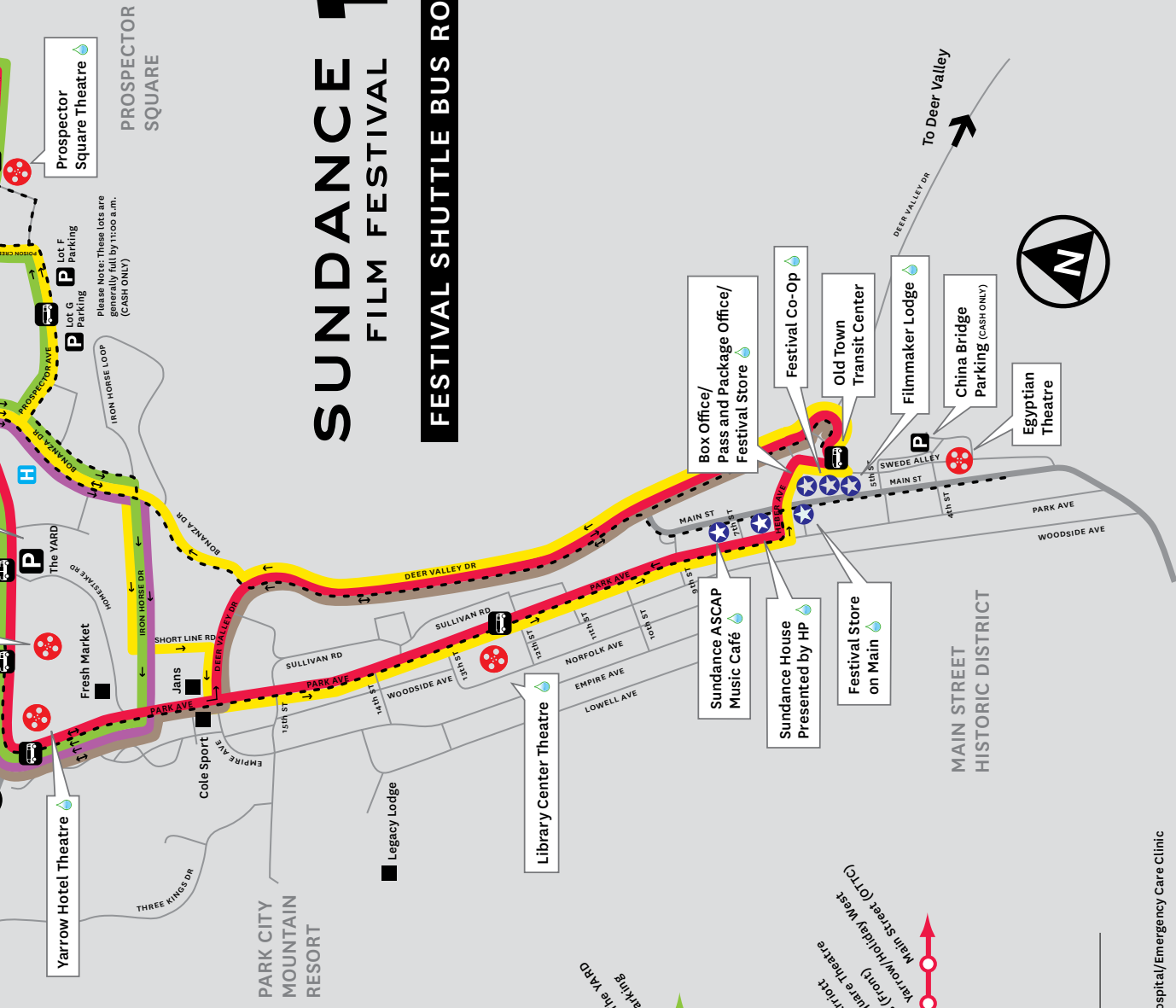
