

How to book your festival Lodging

- **Book ASAP- the sooner the better!**
- Plan your travel dates: The **Full Festival** dates are January 20 - January 30.
 - **Park City premieres** will all screen by Tuesday January 25, with repeat Utah screenings following.
 - **Awards** will be announced Friday January 28, with ONLY award winners screening in person the final Saturday and Sunday.
- If possible we do not recommend staying in Salt Lake City (a 45 minute drive from Park City) or Heber/Midway (a 30 minute drive from Park City). If you choose a hotel in the Heber/Midway area, consider renting a car and parking each day at a designated park and ride lot in Park City and ride the free festival shuttle from there.
- Kimball Junction is about 6 miles from Park City Main Street and may have some great, affordable options. However, do allow yourself extra travel time to get to our theatres and venues. Shuttles to Kimball Junction run until 2 am. ***Search for Best Western, Hampton Inn, Holiday Inn, Crestview Condos, PowderWood, Bear Hollow, and Hyatt Place on the www.sundance.org/lodging site.**
- Most properties require a minimum night stay. Search for at least five nights during first weekend dates and at least three nights during the second week of the Festival.
- There is **NO PARKING** at our theatres and venues. Everyone rides the **FREE** festival shuttles. Find a place near a bus stop.
- It's hard to find places near Main Street. Ask the reservation team to look for condos near town, in the Canyons, Snowpark, or Deer Valley areas.
- **DON'T PANIC-** many places are booked by hopeful filmmakers who are not accepted, and by general patrons who need to cancel their plans. Properties and newer options open up after film selection has been announced.
