As a member of our Festival community, we expect you to help create an inclusive and respectful environment that is welcoming to all by committing to being:

- Inclusive and respectful of people of every race, ethnicity, gender identity/expression, disability, sexual orientation, nationality, religion, age, physical appearance and body size, language spoken, and immigration or economic status. This also includes respecting the decisions of others regarding use of face masks.
- Intentional with your words by abstaining from hate speech or actions of any kind, including abuse of chat functions (e.g., trolling).
- Mindful of the personal space and boundaries of others by avoiding unwelcome sexual attention, harassment, stalking, and inappropriate physical contact of any kind.
- Respectful of moderators, other artists, and audience members by refraining from sustained disruption of screenings, sessions, talks, or other events.
- Conscious of the power you hold by not engaging in abuse or intimidation including that related to race, gender, position, or wealth.
- Considerate of the work of other artists by refraining from phishing and pirating the work of Sundance filmmakers.
- Proactive in prioritizing community health and wellbeing by refraining from attending events when you feel unwell.
- A conscious visitor by treating Park City and Salt Lake City residents and communities with respect.
