Meet The Artist Video

The Sundance Film Festival Meet the Artist video is an opportunity for you to introduce yourself and your film to our audiences! We ask that ALL filmmakers create their own video in their own style and voice. Yours will be featured on your film's project page in our Festival Program Guide, and on our social channels and Youtube page.

Your Meet the Artist video should be between **30 seconds and 2 minutes max**. It can be as simple as a voiceover that includes stills and clips from your film—or can be as adventurous as you see fit. Feel free to get creative! All filmmakers must include English subtitles.*

Added guidance for subtitles: Please provide your subtitles in the form of an .srt file as they will be added to the final video upload as closed captions. Please do not bake the captions into the video.

How to Create an SRT File for Subtitles & Captions

Shooting Requirements:

- Film in Landscape Mode but wide enough that it can be cropped for square or vertical. (See examples above)
- Make sure the footage is well exposed.
- Sound ideally would be with a lav or boom but not required.
 - Minimize background noise as much as possible.
- The background should be representative of you. It adds to the story.

Deliverable Requirements:

- Export 1920×1080, ProRes or H264.
- Provide two versions: one WITH music, one WITHOUT music
- Do not include any graphics over the picture unless that is the original format of the footage.

Script:

- Tell us a little about who you are and your background.
- Give a brief description of the film.
- What makes your story unique? Give us a sense of some of the themes and character journey's (ex. "Our lead really goes through a transformation after she breaks up with her childhood sweetheart" – etc. etc.)
- Tell us a little more about the unique backstory of how this project came to life, and a personal anecdote of what motivated you to persevere and make this film.
- Why Sundance?
- How did you feel about getting the news that your film was accepted to Sundance?
- Outro: (sample) "I can't wait to share this film with you and hope you enjoy it!"

Deadlines:

December 2. Send us your video by this date to guarantee your video will be on the Festival Program Guide when it first launches. We will still accept your video after this date, but we strongly suggest having it done by then since there will be heavy traffic to the Sundance Institute website at this time, maximizing your exposure!

December 20. This is the final date to guarantee your video will be on the Festival Program Guide in time for ticket selection. This is the point when audiences will start making ticket selections, and may use the videos as a way to decide what films they would like to see.
